

Dear presidents, delegates and members of the national associations for supervision and coaching,

**ANSE board would like to inform you about the topics that were discussed and decided at the 39<sup>th</sup> board meeting, June 19<sup>th</sup> till 21<sup>st</sup> 2009.**

1. Summer university 2009 Dublin is approaching very quickly. You have received the registration form. Accommodation for about 50 people is available in Trinity college, please follow the instruction on the registration sheet. In case of any complications, please do not hesitate to call Irish colleagues (the numbers are on the registration sheet).

Due to some complications we will have the final program on July 7<sup>th</sup> and we will communicate it to you the very same moment we get it. Up till now we know, that Michael Carroll will give the lecture, Michaela Judy and Verena Bruchhagen will offer the workshop and the lecture, Sijtze de Roos and Ines Rinke will be leading the workshop about ethics in supervision and coaching. But the most valuable and the core activity of the Summer university and ANSE itself is the chance to experience, live and reflect upon the diversity while actually working and having intervision in international groups. This is the good opportunity for European supervisors and coaches to “improve by doing” the intercultural competences. Josephine Young Buchner will coordinate the groups.

2. Grundtvig program is going on well. The second meeting took place in Amersfoort, Netherlands, June 5<sup>t</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> 2009 and the next meeting will take place in Berlin, the autumn 2009. The content information will be written by the coordinator and published on the ANSE website. As well as the flyer, containing the basic information about the program and participants.
3. Information on the balance and the budget: printed financial report and draft budget proposal will in future be handed out to the delegates at the General assemblies.
4. Projects: ANSE decided to give the content and policy support to the Romanian international educational project.
5. Homepage: the structure for the ANSE data base (the library) is made, so the articles will be published soon. Just a reminder: the English abstract is necessary and the national associations are the ones, responsible for the decision what is to be published on ANSE website.
6. Elections 2010: the new board is to be elected. In.... you will get the formal invitation for the nominations.
7. Contact with EAS has been reactivated. We will stay in touch and exchange information.
8. ANSE will send a letter of information to CEDEFOP about European standards in supervision which we expect to be recognized.
